TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, park, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, bioswale | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting, Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 11 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** felty white, grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** deeply furrowed, furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
