Location: park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest, Prairie planting

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, curiosity

Flowers: raceme, discrete, scented | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, polished, underside hairy, scented with contusion, lobate | **Autumn colour:** orange, scarlet | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey-blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed, furrowed | **Twig colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, polished | **Root system:** shallow, moderately branched, root suckers
