USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, bioswale, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 18 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding
