Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, ecological zone, bioswale | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, owls, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** daffodil | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, hairy, curly | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** capsule, catkins | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** deeply furrowed, spiral | **Twig colour:** yellow, green
