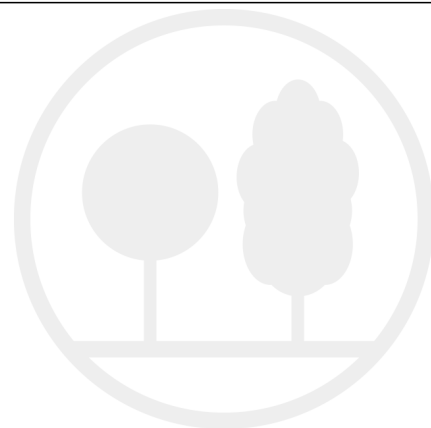

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, owls, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution, tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** pale yellow, yellow, yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown
