TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, woodland planting stock | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, bioswale, coastal area | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, pendulous | **Flower colour:** golden yellow, silver | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green, grey felty | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide, polished, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
