Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, bioswale | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid, egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, pendulous, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown
