## USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** food forest

## CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 4 - 8 m | **Width:** 3 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

**Flowers:** umbels, unpleasantly scented | **Flower colour:** white, cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, scented with confusion, dissected, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** edible, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** black-violet | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-green
