Flowers: catkins, striking | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, brown | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, capsule | **Bark colour:** yellow, pale brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, moderately branched, root suckers
