TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, countryside, bioswale, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 20 - 25 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, striking | **Flower colour:** yellow | **Flowering period:** April - April | **Leaf colour:** matt green, underside grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** yellow, brown | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** golden yellow | **Twigs:** bare, pendulous | **Root system:** deep, extensive
