Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, small garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone, windbreak, bioswale | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 10 m | **Width:** 3 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet, very wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerant to short-term flooding

Flowers: catkins, discrete, pendulous | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, polished | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, catkins | **Fruit colour:** green | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown
