USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 1 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4B - 10A

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
