**Tree types:** feathered trees, conifers

## USE

**Location:** park, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting, shade-tolerant

## CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 30 m | **Width:** 6 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9B

## ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness

**Flowers:** discrete | **Flowering period:** January - December | **Leaf colour:** grey-blue, silver | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** small, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
