Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white-yellow, red-brown | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
