Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: umbels, striking, unpleasantly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, dissected, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** violet-grey | **Bark:** peeling, smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** violet, grey
