Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 8 - 12 m | Width: 4 - 8 m | Winter hardiness zone: 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist, wet | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, unpleasantly scented | Flower colour: cream-white | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: green, underside grey-green | Leaves: deciduous, dissected, pinnate | Autumn colour: yellow-orange, red | Fruits: drupe | Fruit colour: orange-red | Bark colour: violet-grey | Bark: peeling, smooth, later on rough | Twig colour: violet, grey
