TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, park, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** orange, violet | **Fruits:** striking, drupe | **Fruit colour:** yellow, orange-red, red-brown, red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-violet
