Tree types: standard trees | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: umbels, striking, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** grey-green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, wide, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** pale yellow | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown, green
