Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 10 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, unpleasantly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, big, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, orange-red | **Fruits:** large, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** violet-grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** violet, grey
