**Tree types:** standard trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** corymbose | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** matt green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, dentate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange, red | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** grey-green
