USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness
