TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 10 m | **Width:** 5 - 7 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, fire blight resistant

Flowers: corymbose, striking | **Flower colour:** cream | **Flowering period:** May - May | **Leaf colour:** green, underside white-grey | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, pinnate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** orange, red | **Bark colour:** yellow, brown | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** brown, green
