TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 7 - 9 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, underside hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, drupe | **Fruit colour:** orange-red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
