USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** buds violet, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, doubly serrate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, green | **Fruits:** berry | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown, green | **Twigs:** hairy
