Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** very dry, dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds
