USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral (6.6 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, pendulous | **Flower colour:** white, cream-white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, narrow | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** green, pale green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** deep
