Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, urban planting, Eco planting

Height: 0.5 - 1 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 0.8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (6.5 - 7.1) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerant to dryness, tolerates heat

Flowers: umbels, corymbose | **Flower colour:** white, pink | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, narrow, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** highly branched
