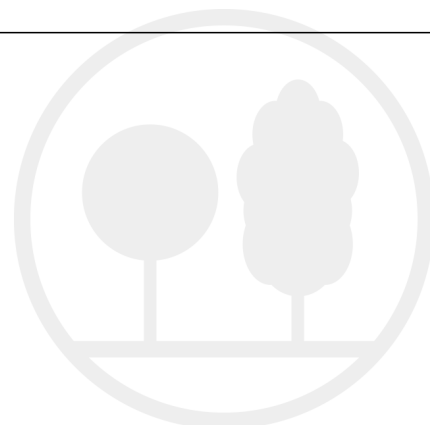
Height: 0.6 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 0.5 - 0.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking, big | **Flower colour:** pale pink, pink | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** pale green, green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, small | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Twig colour:** green, pale green | **Root system:** shallow
