TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, pendulous, singular, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, leathery, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** green | **Fruits:** hairy, discrete, toxic, small, drupe, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed, smooth | **Twig colour:** yellow-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, highly branched, fine roots
