Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, singular, small, scented | Flower colour: white, white-pink | Flowering period: May -June | Leaf colour: buds red-violet, violet-green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, small, matt polished, serrate | Autumn colour: dark violet | Fruits: discrete, rich fruit yield, toxic, small, raceme, drupe, capsule | Fruit colour: grey-green | Bark colour: grey | Bark: slightly furrowed, smooth | Twig colour: grey-brown | Twigs: bare, polished, vertical branches, finely branched | Root system: shallow, slightly branched, fine roots
