Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, singular, small, scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** buds red-violet, violet-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, small, matt polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** dark violet | **Fruits:** discrete, rich fruit yield, toxic, small, raceme, drupe, capsule | **Fruit colour:** grey-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** slightly furrowed, smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, polished, vertical branches, finely branched | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched, fine roots
