USE

Location: street, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 12 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, small, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, small, matt polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, toxic, small, drupe, capsule | **Fruit colour:** green, grey-green, grey | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** slightly furrowed, smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches, finely branched | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched, fine roots
