



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, characteristic trees

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement**: none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, wide egg-shaped, wide pyramidal | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 4 - 6 m | Width: 3 - 4 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | Extreme environments: curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, singular, small, scented | Flower colour: white-pink, pale pink | Flowering period: June - July | Leaf colour: buds violet, violet-green, dark green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, ovoid, matt polished, serrate | Autumn colour: green | Fruits: hairy, discrete, toxic, small, drupe, capsule | Fruit colour: dark violet | Bark colour: red-brown, grey-black | Bark: slightly furrowed, smooth | Twig colour: yellow-brown, brown | Twigs: bare, pendulous, finely branched | Root system: shallow, slightly branched, fine roots
