



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees, solitary shrubs

USE

Location: central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement**: none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 6 - 8 m | Width: 3 - 5 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, nectar value 1, pollen value 1 | Extreme environments: curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, singular, small, scented | Flower colour: white | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: green, buds bright green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, ovoid, small, polished, serrate | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: discrete, rich fruit yield, toxic, small, raceme, drupe, capsule | Fruit colour: grey-blue | Bark colour: grey | Bark: slightly furrowed, smooth | Twig colour: grey-brown | Twigs: bare, polished, vertical branches, finely branched | Root system: shallow, slightly branched, many hair roots
