**Crown shape:** ovoid, wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 6 - 9 m | **Width:** 4 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 9A

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

**Flowers:** bowl-shaped, striking, singular, small | **Flower colour:** white, golden yellow, violet | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, leathery, underside hairy, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red, scarlet, red-violet, violet | **Fruits:** striking, small, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** orange, brown-violet, cinnamon-brown, green | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
