TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, bell-shaped, striking, pendulous, flower-scented, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, orbicular, ovoid, big, wide, polished, undulate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** hairy, discrete, toxic, small, drupe, capsule | **Fruit colour:** yellow-brown | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-violet | **Twigs:** hairy, bare | **Root system:** shallow, central root
