Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 2 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: panicle, pendulous, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white-yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** capsule | **Fruit colour:** yellow-brown | **Bark colour:** brown, green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-green
