USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2.5 - 3 m | **Width:** 2.5 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, striking, pendulous, singular | **Flower colour:** pale yellow | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete, berry, leathery | **Bark colour:** grey-brown, grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
