USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 3 - 8 m | **Width:** 2 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 11A

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** curiosity

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: striking, singular, small, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, golden yellow | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** red-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, serrate | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, small, capsule | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow, slightly branched
