USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Landscape planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.7 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 0.45 - 0.45 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 7A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral (6.8 - 7.5) | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: spikes, panicle | **Flower colour:** golden yellow | **Flowering period:** July - August | **Leaf colour:** golden yellow, bronze-green | **Leaves:** lanceolate, grassy | **Autumn colour:** yellow, golden yellow, yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Root system:** compact
