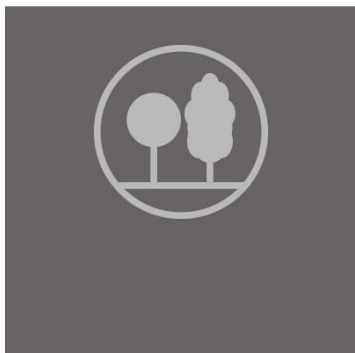

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: woodland planting stock | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray

Flowers: raceme, spikes, bell-shaped, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** white-green, pink | **Flowering period:** May - September | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, small, slightly hairy | **Fruits:** striking, berry, drupe | **Fruit colour:** white, violet | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
