

Flowers: raceme, spikes, bell-shaped, discrete, small | Flower colour: white-green, pink | Flowering period: May - September | Leaf colour: green, underside blue-green | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, small, slightly hairy | Fruits: striking, berry, drupe | Fruit colour: white, violet | Bark colour: red-brown | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: red-brown | Twigs: hairy
