TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** pale violet | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide, opposite | **Autumn colour:** yellow, red-violet, bronze-red | **Twig colour:** violet
