TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees

USE

Location: street, park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 9 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind | **Soil:** light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

Flowers: panicle, infundibular, striking, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** red-brown, violet | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** dark red | **Twigs:** bare
