Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 8 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, stuffed, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, ovoid, big, slightly hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
