TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, woodland planting stock, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** food forest

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: panicle, striking, singular, big, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** violet | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, opposite | **Autumn colour:** yellow, bronze-red | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** grey | **Twigs:** bare
