TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 5 - 10 m | **Width:** 4 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9A

ASPECTS

Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 0, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flower colour:** pale orange | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** buds yellow | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown
