### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** characteristic trees, conifers, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide oval | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9A

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, birds, nectar value 0, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

**Flowers:** discrete, small | **Flower colour:** pale orange, green | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling, furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
