**Location:** park, central reservation, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

#### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

#### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

#### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** discrete | **Flower colour:** pale orange | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** pale green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales, short needles | **Fruits:** discrete, toxic, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** white | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** bare
