Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees, conifers | **Topiary:** cone, hedge element

USE

Location: park, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, windbreak | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 20 m | **Width:** 3 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 3A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** owls | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete, small | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** evergreen, needles or scales | **Fruits:** discrete, small, cones | **Fruit colour:** brown-green | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare
